

Open Master Class on Social Innovation and Territorial Dynamics



The master class is offered by **Hugo Pinto**, Professor of the Faculty of Economics and researcher of CinTurs, and Principal Investigator of the Atlantic Social Lab in CES-University of Coimbra. The class is part of the Tourism Economics & Regional Development master's programme, but is open to the entire academic community.

This is an open class that aims to debate the concept of social innovation and to frame it as a useful tool to address a set of emerging social needs.

One of the structuring dimensions of the innovation process is the monitoring of territorial dynamics and social impacts. In this way, the class focuses on the implementation of the Atlantic Social Innovation Observatory - a resource that aims to stimulate action-research through the collaboration of multiple actors, new approaches, presentation of statistical information, relevant news and mapping of existing social innovation actors in Atlantic different territories.

Particular attention is given to digital transformation and the pilot projects being implemented in Portugal, France, Ireland and Spain.
